## A little more about HIPPY

- HIPPY is designed to be enjoyable for parents/carers, children and the family.
- Families start HIPPY when their child enters kindergarten (usually 4 yrs old) and continues until their child completes pre primary.
- A trained HIPPY tutor makes fortnightly visits to the home or community location to demonstrate the activities to parents or carers.
- HIPPY tutors are parents who are doing the program with their own child.
- Parents/Carers do our fun activities with their child.
- HIPPY provides an invitation to community events and regular Group Meetings.
- HIPPY provides training and learning opportunities.

### **What is HIPPY?**

The Home Interaction Program for Parents and Youngsters (HIPPY) is a two-year, home-based early childhood learning and parenting program that empowers parents and carers as their child's first teacher.

HIPPY is free

HIPPY links learning at home with learning at school

HIPPY helps children make a successful transition to school and beyond

In the first year of HIPPY, families learn skills to get their children ready for school.

In the second year, parents and carers learn more about supporting their children's learning and development at school and at home.

Families spend 10 to 15 minutes a day doing educational activities with their children.

A trained HIPPY Tutor meets with the family regularly to practice HIPPY activities.

HIPPY families receive a HIPPY box, craft supplies, story books, activity packs and resources to share.
